

Pilkington Sailing Club Protests

The procedures will follow the RRS Appendix L with the following local changes:

1. Verbal intention of protest to the Race Officer who will advise the Protest Convenor
2. A written protest should be completed within 30 minutes of the end of the race (only extended in exceptional circumstances)
3. If it is not possible to hold the protest meeting that day, then the day and date of the meeting should be arranged and given to both parties
4. The protest panel should consist of the Convenor and two suitably experienced and impartial members of the Club
5. In the event of an appeal being made against the decision or redress, the Sailing Committee will determine the necessary action. If not satisfactory, the General Committee will have the final decision.
