Topper Series	Four series will be based on 1) all Sunday series up to the end of series 1,2,3,7 2) Remaining Sunday series. 3) Frostbite series. 4) Weekday series. Helmsmen must be under 18 years of age at the start of the season. Points to the helmsman.
Endeavour Series	Only helmsmen who have not won a Sunday or Weekday series, (excluding the short flight series) or an Open Meeting are eligible. (Note: a one day event does not exclude) Points to the helmsman.
Novices Series	Presented by Mr W J Rhodes. Only this year's Beginners helm and crew are eligible. The sailing committee reserves the right to refuse entry. Anyone in doubt should apply for a ruling. Points to the helmsman.
Under 18 Trophy	Presented by Mr J D Logan. Helm and crew must be under 18 on the day of the race. Points to the helmsman.

Southern Cross Trophy	<p>Presented by Mr P R Bailey</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The helmsman and crew must be paid up members of Pilkington Sailing Club; 2. Neither helmsman or crew are to have won any Pilkington Sailing Club race series consisting of not less than 10 races, Novice, Alpha and any single handed series will be disregarded; 3. The trophy will be awarded on the result of three races sailed on a single day. There will be no disregard race; 4. The day chosen shall be nominated by the sailing committee and not less than 4 weeks written notice to be given to Pilkington Sailing Club Members; 5. If racing is abandoned on the nominated day, the trophy shall not be awarded that year; 6. Helmsmen and crew shall race together to qualify; 7. Where the term helmsman is used in the above conditions, this will be taken to include helmswoman; <p>The above conditions may be changed either with the written permission of Mr P R Bailey or by a ¾ majority of those present and voting at an A.G.M. of the Pilkington Sailing Club</p>
Mistral Trophy	<p>Presented by Mr D B Lunt</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Only Helman who has not won a series (excluding the short flight series), Endeavour and Teign Series) or Event during the current year are eligible; 2. The trophy will be sailed for on the basis of the best results obtained in the Frostbite series; 3. The points will be awarded on the basis of the helman's final position in each of the Frostbite races relative to the other eligible helmsmen sailing in that race; 4. The trophy will be held for one year 5. Any matter arising and not covered by the above, will be referred to the Sailing Committee for a decision. Points to the helmsman.
Parkin Trophy	<p>Presented by Mr R A Parkin – This will take the form of a number of knockout races between individual helmsmen. A draw will be made and the Race Officer will decide the times of the race appropriate to the number of entrants. Each race will consist of two laps. All entrants shall notify the Race Officer of their wish to enter and to pay the entry fee before the closing time. Details of the race, closing time and entry fee are given in the Race Programme. Points to the helmsman.</p>
Gill Trophy	<p>Presented by Mr E P Gill</p> <p>This trophy will be awarded for the best performance based on 50% of the races sailed in the Sunday series including the Frostbite series. If the boat or helmsman has won any other series, (excluding the short flight series), during that season then he shall be excluded.</p>
Traveller Trophy	<p>Presented by Mr J Stead</p> <p>Awarded for the best performance by a Pilkington Sailing Club Enterprise in Open Meetings and Regattas not sailed on Pilkington Sailing Club waters. The best 6 results will count. For Top Helm events the overall results for each meeting will count and not the overall result for the series. In other events where any prize is awarded for the overall performance in several races sailed on 3 or more days, then only the overall result will count. This applies specifically to the Menai Regattas / National / International Championships and Bassenthwaite Week. Any helmsman wishing to qualify for the trophy must submit the results to the Hon Sailing Secretary by 1st November of the year in question.</p>

Barraddel-Smith Trophy	Presented by Mrs Barraddel-Smith This will be awarded for a special event with the objective of promoting “something different, light hearted but requiring a degree of skill” in the general area of sailing. The Sailing Committee will decide on the form and timing of the event. Points to the helmsman.
Teign Trophy	Presented by Mr Birkenhead Only helmsmen who hve not won a Sunday or Weekday series, (excluding the short flight series), or an Open Meeting are eligible (Note: a one day event does not exclude) Points to the helmsman
Divisional Racing	Helmsmen will be divided into 3 divisions by the sailing committee. There will be 2 sets of prizes based on all the races in the Sunday series in the periods a) before the change in series in mid June. A set of prizes will also be based on all the races in the Weekday Series M1, M2, M3. Points will be awarded to helmsmen relative to the other helmsmen from the same Division sailing in the race. Prizes will be awarded to the first helmsman in each Division and to crews nominated by those helmsmen.
RNLI and KGFS Races	The entry fee will be given to the appropriate Charity is given in the Race Programme
Under 18 Series	All helmsmen will be under the age of 18 on the day of the first race of the series.
Ladies Race	Presented by Mr R V Ulwin Boats in the race shall be helmed by ladies. Points to the helmswoman.
Eccleston Bowl	This trophy will be sailed for by two teams of members. The team captains will select members present alternately until all present are selected
Handicap Series	A set of 7 handicap series based on the Sunday series and two based on the three Weekday series will be offered. The total points from the best results in the number of races to count for the particular Handicap Series will be adjusted by individual handicaps. The handicaps will be calculated on the basis of up to the last 100 races in which the helmsman finished and did not retire. Where this is not possible the Sailing Committee will apply a handicap. Whilst the Sailing Committee may vary a handicap at any time, it is expected that adjustments will normally be made only after the first half of the season. i.e. Sunday Handicap 3 and Weekday Handicap 8
Searcher Trophy	Presented by Mrs F E Lunt in memory of her husband Derek Lunt <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Helm ad crew shall be paid up members of Pilkington S.C. 2. There will be a single race for the trophy 3. Helm and Crew shall be members of the same family 4. Either helm or crew shall be under 21 on the day of the race
Winter Series	Trophies will be presented for the winning boats in series 1 & 2: Note series 1 will comprise the first race series 2 will comprise the second race.
Aubrey Cup	Presented by Mr Percy Aubrey. Awarded for the best two out of three races on a specific day.
Graham Thompson Trophy	For the fastest lap by a member of Pilkington S.C. (Junior) in the Southport S.C. 12 Hour Race
Commodores Cup	Presented by Mr J D Lee for the fastest lap by a Pilkington Sailing Club member in the West Lancashire Yacht Club 24 Hour Race.
